Dear Father,

To ensure high quality teaching, the Catholic Church of Luxembourg has always been committed to ensure pedagogical teaching of a high level at the European School institutions.

To this end, I am asking for your assistance in providing us with names of qualified people in your community who would be willing to give classes of religion as teachers or substitutes in primary and/or secondary in the two European Schools in Luxembourg, located in Kirchberg and Mamer. Candidates must hold the nationality of a European Union member state.
