**Welcome back from Fr HP and Fr Ed!** We are delighted to be able to celebrate Mass with some of our community in St Alphonse this Sunday and we look forward to being able to welcome more of you soon. If you are unable to attend Mass at the moment, please continue to follow the 11.30 Mass online. If you know of anyone who cannot attend Mass, who may not be aware of the updates or who would like a visit from a priest, please contact the parish office in the first instance.

**New times and arrangements for Sunday Mass:** Please note the change of times in Sunday Masses in English: **11.30 am and 6.30 pm**. To attend either of these Masses please call the parish office during office hours (8 - 12 noon) on 661 127 962 to book a place. This is in line with the directive received from the Archdiocese for current Covid-19 restrictions. Places are limited to ensure social distancing.

On arriving at the church you will be asked to clean your hands with antiseptic gel and you will be given a seat number. Please wear a mask. There will be no entry from the courtyard, only by the main doors. We have volunteer welcomers at each Mass who will show you to your seat, provide direction for coming up to receive Holy Communion and leaving the church at the end of Mass, so that we maintain social distancing.

The collection will be taken as you leave the church. Thank you for your support with these measures - we are trying to keep our community safe!

### OPENING HYMN : Here I am to worship

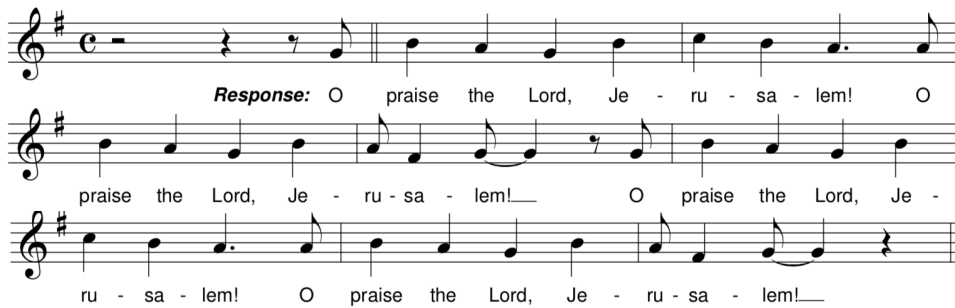
