If you are unable to attend Mass at the moment, please continue to follow the 11.30 Mass online. **New times and arrangements for Sunday Mass:** Please note the change of times in Sunday Masses in English: **11.30 am and 6.30 pm.** On arriving at the church you will be asked to clean your hands with antiseptic gel and you will be given a seat number. Please wear a mask. There will be no entry from the courtyard, only by the main doors. We have volunteer welcomers at each Mass who will show you to your seat, provide direction for coming up to receive Holy Communion and leaving the church at the end of Mass, so that we maintain social distancing.

The collection will be taken as you leave the church. Thank you for your support with these measures - we are trying to keep our community safe!

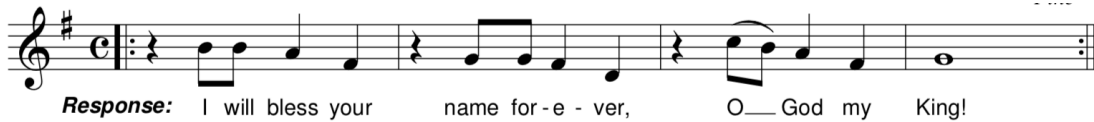
