Times and arrangements for Sunday Mass: Please note the change of times in Sunday Masses in English: 11.30 am and 6.30 pm. Please wear a mask. There will be no entry from the courtyard, only by the main doors. We have volunteer welcomers at each Mass who will show you to your seat, provide direction for coming up to receive Holy Communion and leaving the church at the end of Mass, so that we maintain social distancing. The collection will be taken as you leave the church. Thank you for your support with these measures - we are trying to keep our community safe!

Ilula Orphanage Program: in spite of Covid -19 and having to move out of the church last summer we have been able to donate 2000€ from the after Mass tea and coffee service to the Ilula Orphanage Project since March 2019. Sincere thanks to all who serve on the tea/coffee rotas and to those who donate biscuits or cakes from time to time.

Children's Liturgy: There will be no Children's Liturgy during the 11.30 am Mass over the summer. The team hope to re-start for the new school year.

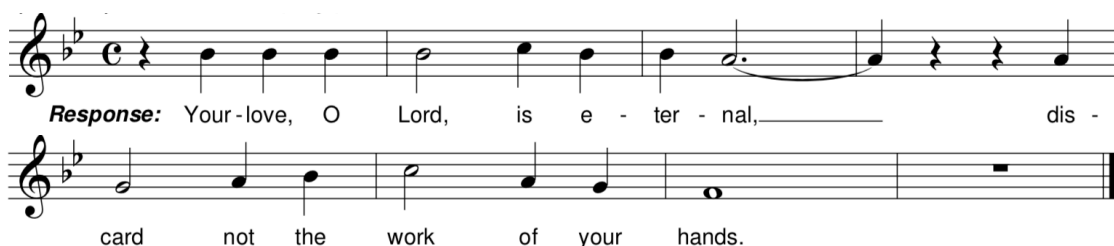
