Saturday Vigil Mass cancelled: Please note that this Mass is cancelled throughout July, August and September.

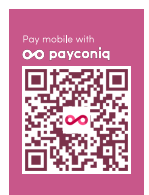
Tea and coffee after Belair Mass: Please join us for refreshments after Mass: all donations received go to the Ilula Orphanage Program.

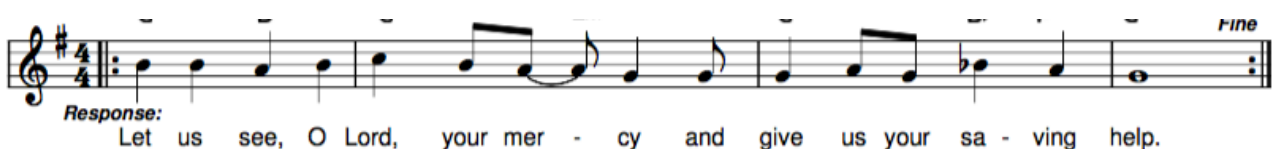

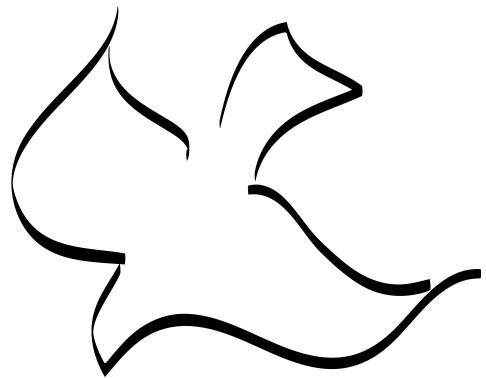


PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS : In bread, we bring you, Lord
