Parish office update: We welcome Caroline King to the parish office as the new administrative assistant. She will be working alongside Nicola and will take over the role in full from 7 October.

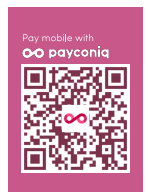
