COMMUNION I: Come back to me

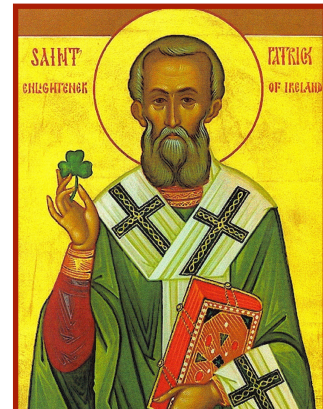
1. Come back to me with all your heart,
