
## MUSICIANS PLAYING FOR UKRAINE

## **Spending the Money to Save Lives in Ukraine**

Healthy Initiatives, a Ukrainian NGO, once focused on public health in Eastern Europe. Since the war, it now raises funds for ambulances to evacuate wounded civilians and soldiers, along with CAT tourniquets to save lives. In 2024, it delivered 85 ambulances to Ukraine's frontlines. Russian forces continue targeting ambulances and healthcare facilities. Each ambulance costs €8,000, a crucial price for survival.
