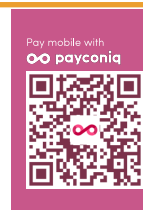

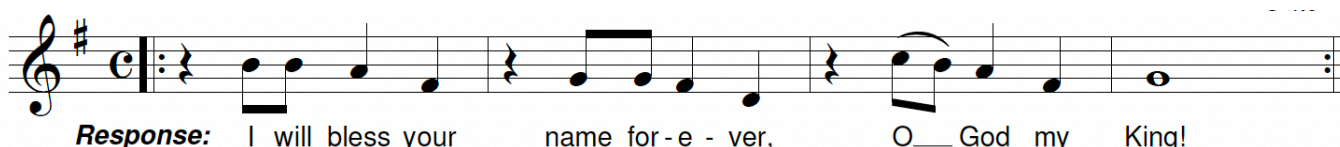
OPENING HYMN : Give us faith, Lord
