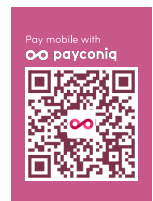

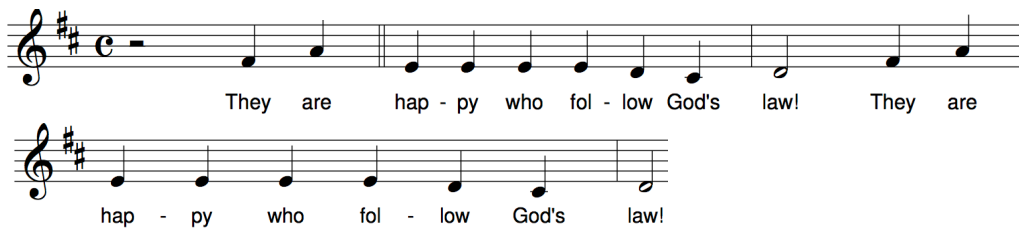
**OPENING HYMN : Send down the Fire**
