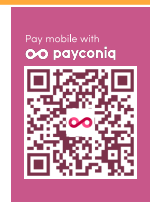

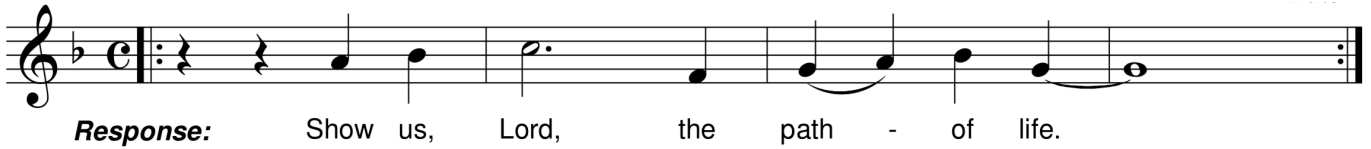


OPENING HYMN : Gather the people
