First Holy Communion and Confirmation 2026-2027: Applications for registration for catechetical preparation for First Holy Communion and Confirmation is now open and will close the 28th of September. Please register with the parish office on parish@catholic.lu and ensure that we have a clear email contact for you.

First Communion candidates should be 8 years old by 1st of January 2027 and prepared to attend Sunday classes and Mass from the beginning of the programme to the end.

Confirmation candidates should be 16 years old by 1st of January 2027 and prepared to attend Sunday classes and Mass from the beginning of the programme to the end.

Adult Confirmation candidates can apply for their Confirmation programme which will be online and require three evening meetings on dates in November, December and January.

When registration is completed you will receive an email with all the details and requirements.
